POSITION PAPER OF THE CITY CLERK

SUBJECT:

ORDER #20-16/17 – Arts & Historic Preservation Committee, Greater Portland Landmarks representative, appointing Alessa Wylie for an unexpired term which expires on 10/20/16. Passage requires majority vote.

POSITION:

As part of the continued implementation of the City's Comprehensive Plan that was passed in October, 2012, the City Council established an Arts and Historic Preservation Committee. The purpose of the Arts & Historic Preservation Committee (AHPC) is to assist the City Council in preserving the historical and architectural integrity of South Portland, fostering beautification of public areas, and promoting the educational, cultural, economic, aesthetic value, and general welfare of South Portland.

The AHPC shall consist of nine (9) members, all of whom shall be residents of the City. There shall be no more than three (3) members from any one voting district. There shall be one member who is a representative of the South Portland Historical Society and one member who is a representative of Greater Portland Landmarks.

Jane Batzell, current Greater Portland Landmarks representative, has recently accepted a new position as President of the Board and is resigning to focus on her new role. Alessa Wylie, Greater Portland Landmarks' Manager of Education Programs, is seeking the role as Greater Portland Landmarks new representative on the Arts and Historic Preservation Committee with the full support of Greater Portland Landmarks and the Arts and Historic Preservation Committee.
