Summary/Description:

A number of young South Portlanders recently petitioned the council to build a skatepark on city property. Skateparks are now widely viewed by municipalities as public assets where kids can safely hone skills and socialize. Neighboring communities, such as Portland, Bath, and Wells, are now strong advocates for these parks. And some of our youngest residents would like us to bring that experience home. Proposed sites include lots abutting the recreation center as well as the vacancy at O'Neil St. The city is currently preparing an inventory of many small lots. I invite my fellow councilors to explore the concept and funding of this park.
