I am writing to request that Mountain View Road and Nutter Road be closed to through traffic on Saturday, September, 27th 2014, from 3:00 PM – 10:30 PM.

The South Portland High School Marching Band is hosting an MBDA Marching Band Home Show on that date at the high school football field. This band competition will feature performances by approximately 10 – 12 area high school bands. The Show starts at 6:00 PM.


The purpose of the road closure is to provide a parking area for the buses bringing in the visiting schools' students (Mountain View) and for the safe unloading of equipment off of Nutter. We plan to arrange for barricades to be placed at either end of Mountain View (at Highland and Nelson) as well as at either end of Nutter (Evans and Highland). The barricades as well as the entry and departure of the buses will be supervised by volunteers from the Music Boosters.

I have attached a form supplied by the city of South Portland with the signatures of area residents in proximity to SPHS, attesting to the fact that they have been advised of this request.


