POSITION PAPER OF THE CITY CLERK

SUBJECT:

ORDER #133-16/17 – Board of Education, District Four, to fill a vacancy pursuant to Section 904 of the City Charter until Inauguration Day, December 4, 2017. Passage requires majority vote.

POSITION:

Libby Reynolds has resigned from the Board of Education - District Four. Her unexpired term expires in December 2018.

Per the City Charter, Sec. 904, "Whenever a vacancy in the school board occurs the vacancy may be filled by a majority vote of all the members of the city council and the member so elected shall serve until the next regular municipal election when a new member shall be elected to fill the vacancy for the unexpired term, if any."

Candidate(s) from the workshop held on February 22, 2017 have been interviewed by the City Council and ORDER #133 is to fill the District Four seat until the November 2017 municipal election and until the elected official takes office on Inauguration Day, December 4, 2017.

REQUESTED ACTION:

The candidate who receives majority vote by the Council will be appointed. ORDER #133-16/17 will need to be amended to add in the name of the appointee and then passed.
