WHEREAS, on May 15, 2017, the City Council adopted Resolve #27-16/17, that \$35,855,791.50 be appropriated for the total cost of funding public education from pre-kindergarten to grade 12 as described in the Essential Programs and Services Funding Act and that \$29,883,101.17 be raised as the City's contribution to the total cost of funding public education from pre-kindergarten to grade 12 as described in the Essential Programs and Services Funding Act in accordance with the Maine revised Statutes, Title 20-A, section 15688. Passage requires majority vote.

Explanation: The City's contribution to the total cost of funding public education from pre-kindergarten to grade 12 as described in the Essential Programs and Services Funding Act is the amount of money determined by state law to be the minimum amount that the municipality must raise in order to receive the full amount of State dollars.

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to amend the appropriation amount to reflect the updated budget;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that Resolve #27-16/17 be and hereby is amended as follows [additions are underlined, deletions are ~~struck through~~]:
